

Registration Manual of Lenovo OTP Windows 64-bit PC Version



The Windows 64-bit PC version now supports concurrent use with mobile (Android/iOS) versions.
(Previous Windows 32-bit version does not.)

The latest OTP Windows 64-bit version No.: v2.0.0

Please follow the steps to download, install, and register Lenovo OTP.

Part 1: Download and Install Lenovo OTP Windows 64-bit PC Version




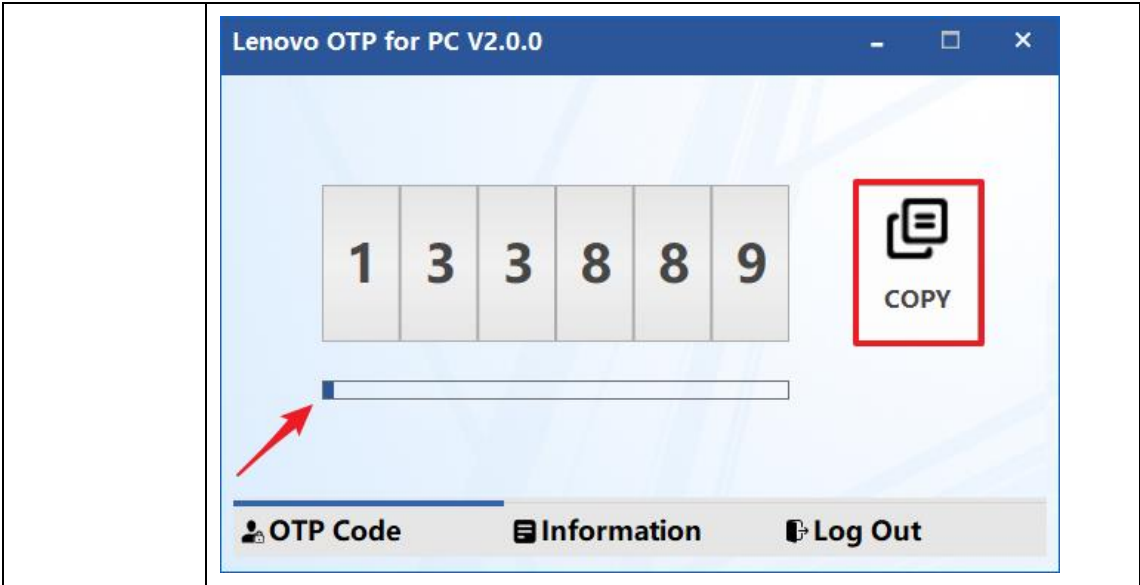

| <p>Step 1</p> <p>Visit Lenovo OTP portal, click [Get Ready] to obtain Lenovo OTP Windows 64-bit PC version</p> |  |
| <p>Step 2</p> <p>Download Lenovo OTP</p> | <p>Lenovo OTP Windows 64-bit PC version, click the button to download</p>  |

In the short term, users can still download and install the Lenovo OTP Windows 32-bit PC version, but the 32-bit version cannot be used in parallel with the mobile APP (Android/Apple) Lenovo OTP.

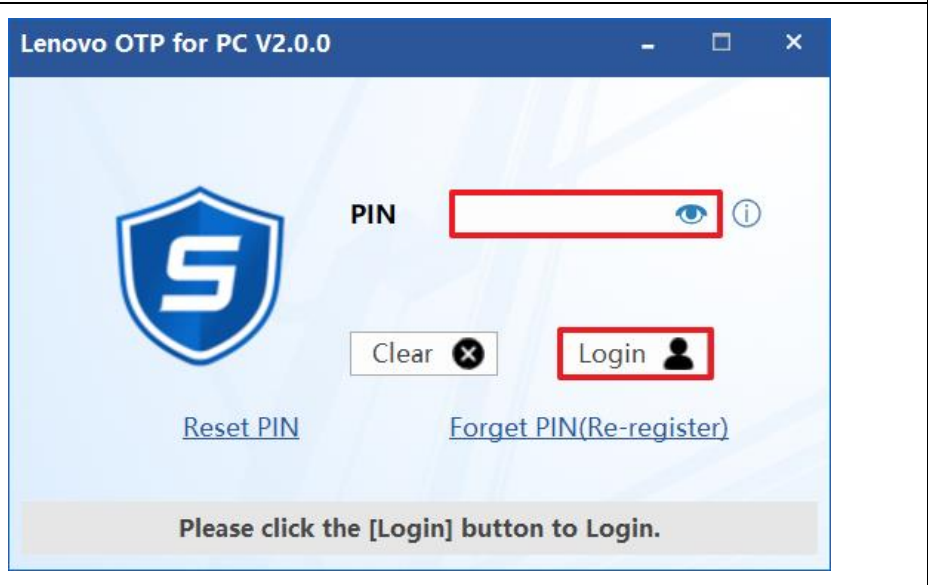
Part 2: Register Lenovo OTP Windows 64-bit PC Version

Registration with Lenovo Employee ID (users may need to contact HR to obtain their own Employee ID)

| <p>Step 2 Set PIN code</p> | <p>Enter PIN code and confirm, then click [Set] button to complete setting</p>  |
| <p>Step 3 Registration completed once PIN code is set</p> | <p>Click the [COPY] button, or use the Ctrl+C to copy the OTP code to the system clipboard; lower part is the OTP code refresh timing progress bar</p> |

PIN code is required when login Lenovo OTP





Registration without Lenovo Employee ID

Notice:

Users who do not have an Employee ID need to switch on the [No Employee ID] option, and then continue the registration.

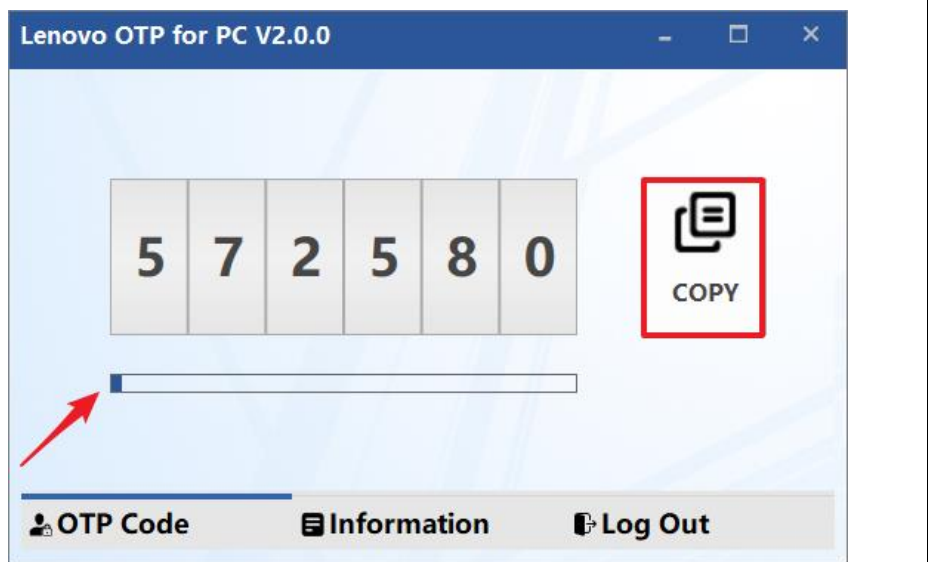
After users who do not have an employee ID complete the registration, their line managers will receive an activation email from OTPAAdmin@lenovo.com; the help from managers is required according to the email guidance during the users completing the activation part.




Click the [COPY] button, or use the Ctrl+C to copy the OTP code to the system clipboard; lower part is the OTP code refresh timing progress bar

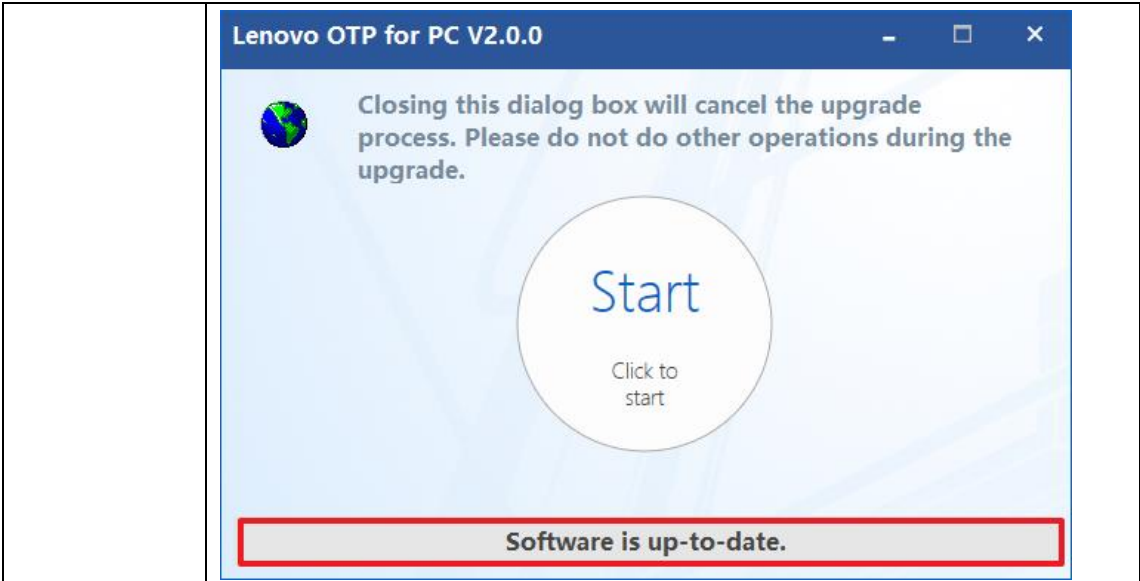

Part 3: Additional Functions of Menu Bar (New features of 64-bit PC version)

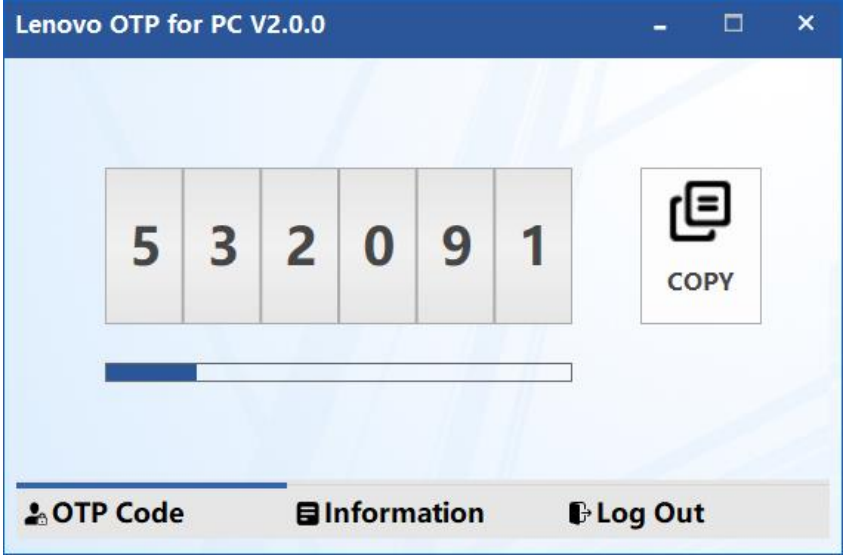
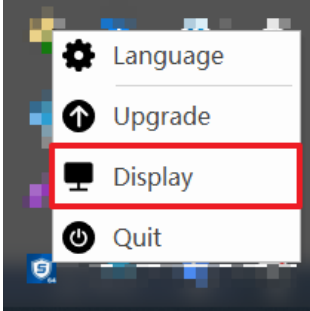
Users can find the Lenovo OTP 64-bit PC version icon  in the tray. By right clicking, following features are presented

| <p>1. Language setting</p> | <p>Click [Language] to switch language settings</p>  <p>Select the language the user prefer, and click the button on the right side of the language item to change</p>  |
| <p>2. Program upgrade</p> | <p>Click [Upgrade] to enter the upgrade interface</p>  <p>Enter the upgrade interface, and the current version information will be shown at the lower part; If an upgrade is needed, simply click [Start] to begin the download</p> |



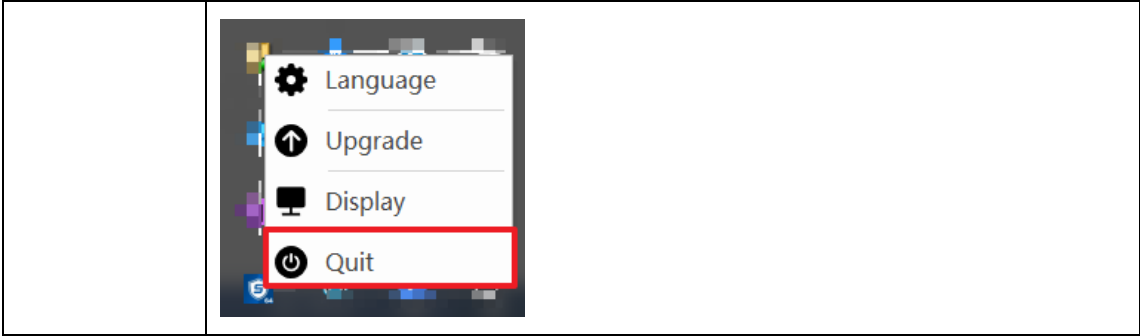
3. Display window

Click [Display] to re-display the Lenovo OTP window at the position where the window was closed last time



4. Exit client

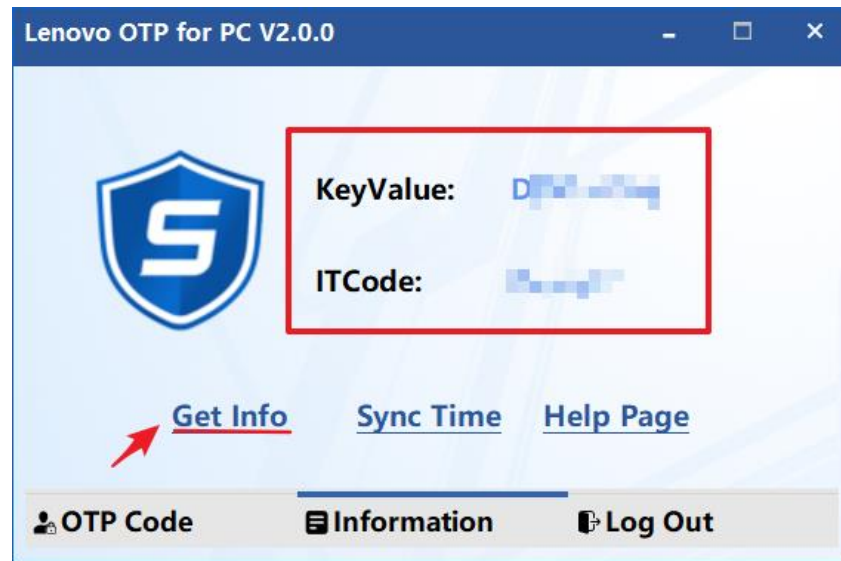
Click [Exit] to exit the client



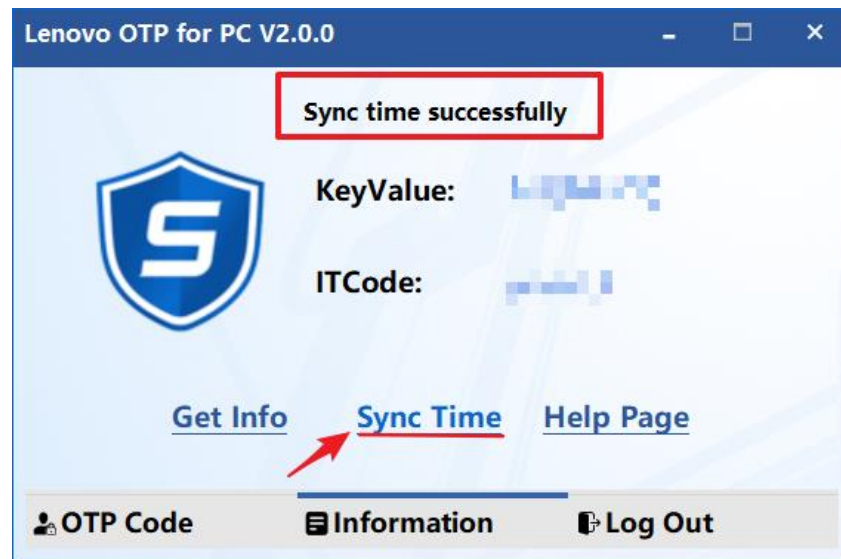
Part 4: Other Features Instruction of PC 64-bit Version

1. Device registration information query

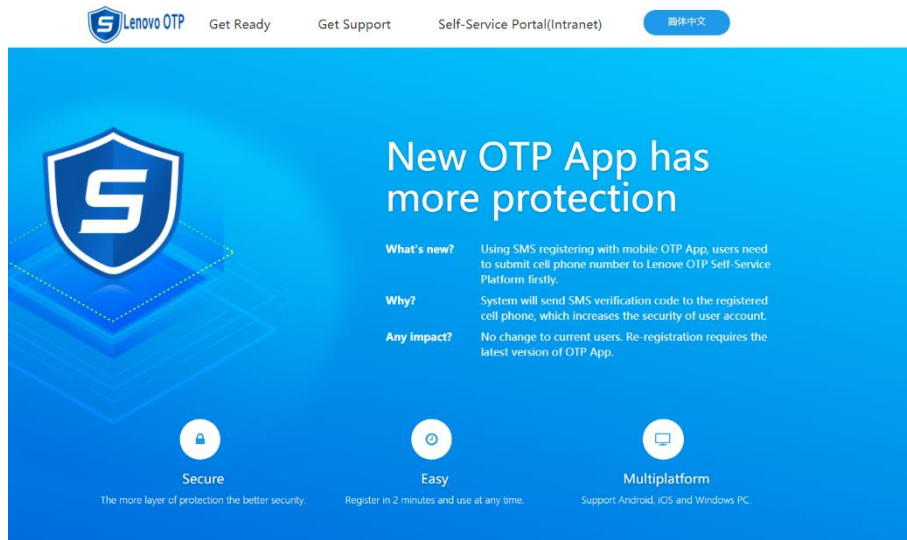
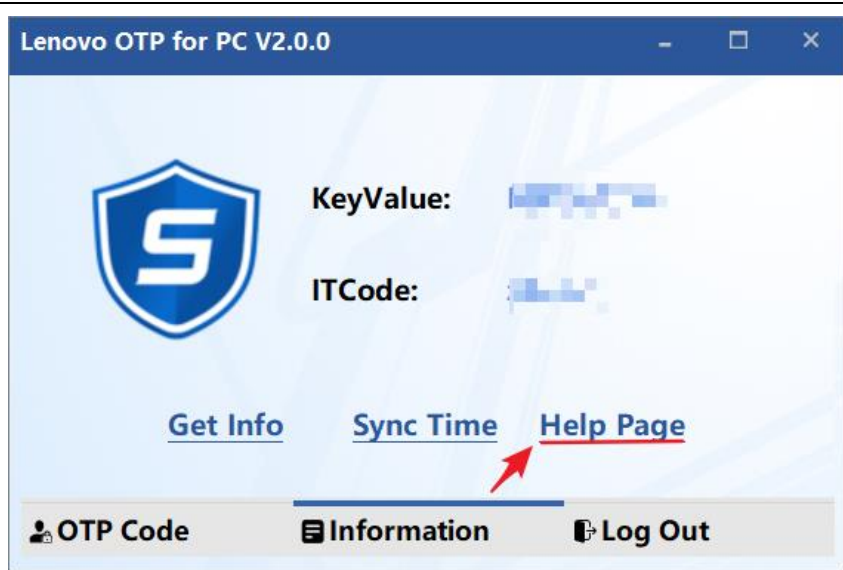
Get Info: Click to copy "KeyValue" and "ITcode", which can be provided to engineers to view the usage problem



Sync Time: For synchronizing the misaligned time. If the time zone switch causes the OTP code to be unavailable, please click this button to synchronize time

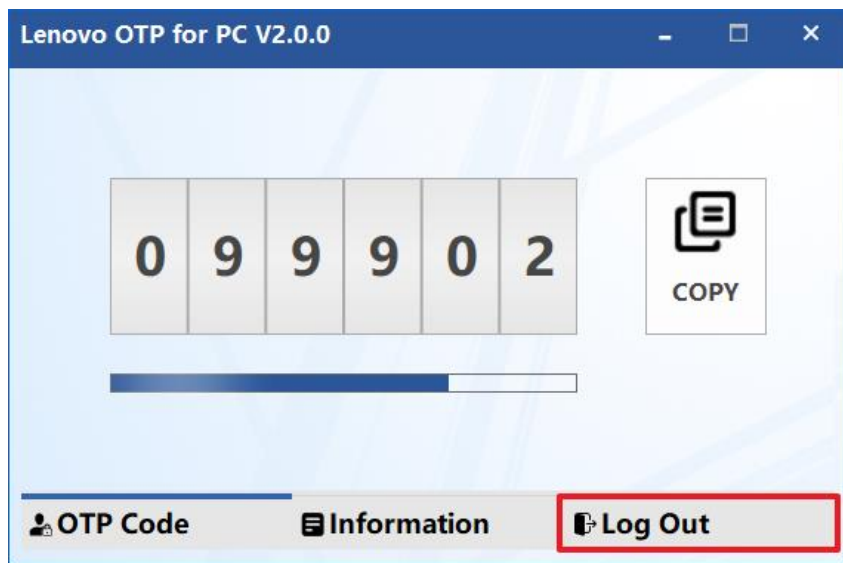


Help Page: It links to Lenovo OTP Portal

Click [Log Out] button

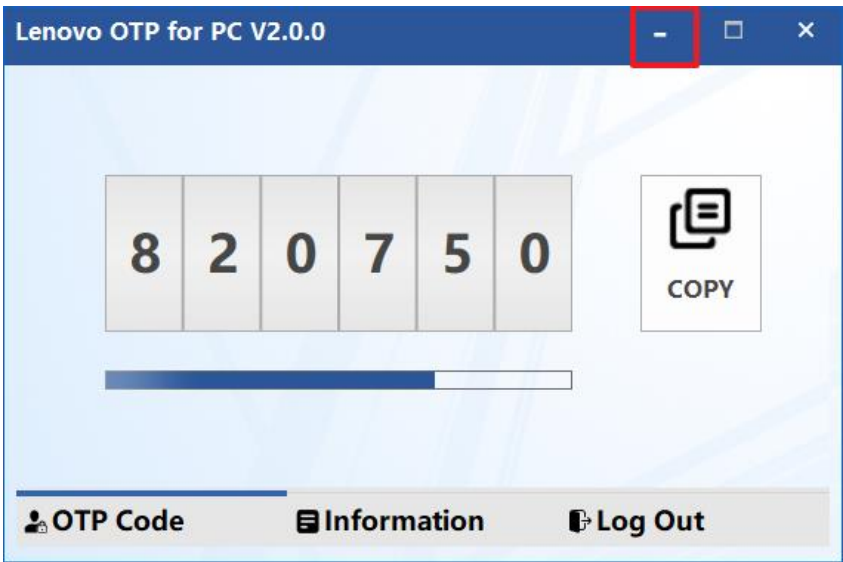


It will return to the login interface
